The paper should not be of more than 2500 words. It should be typed in normal 10 point, Times New Roman. The formatting specifications are: double space with margins-top: 1 inch; bottom: 1-inch; left: 1.25 inches; and right: 1.25 inches. The authors' names and addresses should be written at the centre below the title. All paragraphs must be indented and justified. References should be in MLA format.

- 2. Name, institutional affiliation, e-mail, standard mailing address and phone/cell number should be mentioned in the submissions
