The college embarked upon its journey on 1st June, 1944, as MAHARANI MAHILA (COLLEGE) through Mahila Education Society (registered body of the then prominent and respectable women of Jammu) at the instance of MAHARANI TARADEVI. It was taken over by the Govt. of J&K on 25th November, 1953 and was renamed as Government College for Women, Parade Ground, Jammu. It was the first women college of Jammu province upto 1971. Located in the foot hills of "Mata Vaishno Devi and shores of sared "Suryaputri Tawishi" in the old Jammu city area. This is the only college in Jammu Province that offers the largest number of courses ranging from Arts to Science and Commerce to B.C.A with 30 subjects and 66 combinations available to the students. A total of 6500 students are pursuing their degrees in various disciplines including PG in Home Science (Community Resource Management & Extension), English, Zoology, Computer Applications and Music. The college has faculty strength of 100 permanent teachers. As higher education has to be commensurate with market demand for placement of students, this college has aptly received Grant in aid from UGC for Career Oriented Courses. This college has been acting as a platform for organizing national and state-level seminars, to sensitize the latent talent within students.
